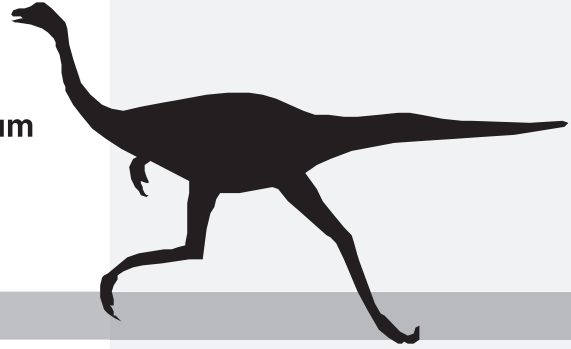


Science Sleuths
