TITLE I HOPE

Title I Homeless Outreach Program for Education has been in existence since 1991. The program has grown in the past 5 years, along with the population of Clark County. Title I HOPE is governed by the McKinney-Vento Act, which remains the only major federal legislative response to homelessness. The Act was reauthorized under No Child Left Behind and states that school districts must comply by providing the following services for homeless students:

1. Immediate enrollment in school;
2. Free breakfast and lunch; and
3. If requested, transportation to remain at student's school of origin.

In addition, Title I HOPE provides backpacks, which are filled with school supplies and toiletries. The program works in collaboration with the Assistance League of Las Vegas to provide clothing for students kindergarten through eighth grade. In order to provide additional services and special programs we look to form partnerships with organizations that will help us, help our students.

WAYS TO HELP



THE GIFT OF HOPE

This fundraiser asks for the participants to donate gift cards from major stores, which will help a homeless child to attend school with the pride and dignity all children need and desire. The Title I HOPE office will carefully purchase clothing and other necessary items for the students through your Gift of Hope.

HOPE FOR CHANGE

This fundraiser asks participants to give their pocket change for homeless students. The money is collected and used to buy gift cards. Then the cards are used by Title I HOPE to provide emergency needs for individual students.

DRIVE FOR HOPE

This fundraiser asks participants to donate hygiene items for homeless students. The items are collected and placed in the backpacks that are provided to students. The following items are needed for distribution:
