Dear Parent, Temporary Guardian, or Unaccompanied Youth:

The McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Improvements Act of 2001 entitles your child or yourself (unaccompanied youth) to specific rights as it deals with **school of origin**.

If you live in:

- A shelter
- A hotel, motel or recreational vehicle
- A doubled-up situation because of economic hardship
- A campground, park, car or the street

Your child or yourself (unaccompanied youth) has the right to:

- Immediately enroll in school
- Choose the:
 - **School of Origin** (where your child or an unaccompanied youth attended when permanently housed or the last school attended) if feasible; or
 - School for which your child or the unaccompanied youth is now zoned.
- Receive transportation assistance from the Clark County School District if the choice is to remain at the **school of origin** and the distance to the school exceeds the two (2) mile limit.

If the **school of origin** is the choice, the clerk or registrar will ask you to complete a **Transportation Request Form**. Please include a current phone number where you can be reached. As soon as transportation arrangements have been made, a Title I HOPE staff member will notify you.
